4. <u>Your Wine Cellar</u>:

*Chateau Margaux Bordeaux (1982): A 96+ point wine described in *International Wine Cellar* as deep ruby-red, boysenberry, cassis, toasty oak and bitter chocolate on the slightly dusty nose; penetrating and powerful. Finishes very tannic and very long, with a strongly spicy character; drink now until 2030, *donated by <u>David Dorsen</u>*, *Sedgwick LLP*. *Quilceda Creek's Cabernet Sauvignon (2004) and Merlot (2004: From Washington State, Robert Parker's *Wine Advocate* bestowed 99 points + on the past eight vintages of Quilceda Creek's Cabernet Sauvignon, including the "lustrous" 2004 (99 pts). The "superb" 2004 Merlot (94 pts), is a "lush Merlot that offers layers of sweet fruit, complex flavors, light tannins, and a sense of sophistication," *donated by <u>Elaine Metlin</u>*, *Dickstein Shapiro and Andrew Clark*.

*School House Vineyards' Pinot Noir (2008), Syrah Blend (2008), and Chardonnay (2009): From the Napa Valley. Produced in a tiny winery and sold almost exclusively to their mailing list, these bottles are nearly impossible to find on the East Coast. Peak drinking window ends in about 2018, *donated by <u>Matthew Reinhard</u>, Miller Chevalier.* *Joseph Phelps Vineyards "Insignia" Napa Valley Proprietary Red (1993): Rated 95/100 by Robert Parker's *Wine Advocate* upon release in 1996. Peak drinking window ends about 2018, *donated by <u>Ted Howard</u>, Wiley Rein.* *Colgin Estate Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley Herb Lamb Vineyard (1993): Rated 96/100 by the *Wine Spectator* upon release in late 1995. Peak drinking window ends in about 2020, *donated by <u>Ted Howard</u>, Wiley Rein.* *16-bottle Wine Enthusiast Silent Touchscreen Wine Refrigerator: This specialty item will keep your wines at the perfect temperature, *donated by <u>Ted Howard</u>, Wiley Rein.*

5. Virginia Countryside Getaway: Weekend stay at Two Creek Farm, a classic restored farmhouse (2BR/2BA), circa 1852, remodeled in 1992, home adjoins Shenandoah National Park, *donated by Jack McKay*, *Pillsbury*; a gift certificate for dinner at the nearby luxurious and award-winning Inn at Little Washington and a bottle of fine wine selected by the Inn's sommelier.
